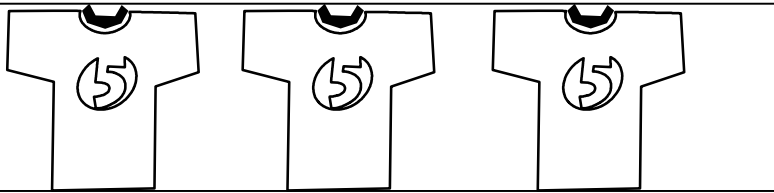

We are machines that test fabrics to BSI standards. What are we testing for?

Answers
For - brings in new skills and trains workers who would otherwise have remained unskilled, other companies set up business in the area once the infrastructure is in place, brings economic growth to the area.
Against - environmental laws may not be as strict, might be no minimum wage, more difficult to do checks on how well the workers are paid and looked after because of distance.
Law - BS5852 states that furnishings and furnishing fabrics must be fire retardant
Fabric testing machines - testing for pilling and abrasion
Reducing production costs - buy in bulk, increase efficiency and reduce waste, reduce the amount of hand sewing and complex techniques
